Oriana House, Inc., began in Akron in 1981 under the direction of its current President and CEO, James Lawrence, as a single program for offenders charged with DUI. Today Oriana House is recognized as an innovative leader in community corrections, staffing 585 employees and operating more than 25 community corrections, chemical dependency treatment, and reentry programs in Summit, Cuyahoga, and Seneca counties. In its 30 years of operation, Oriana House had carried out its commitment to provide safe, proven, and effective sanctions and programming for appropriate offenders, positively impacting countless lives. Oriana House and its staff have been recognized with numerous international, state, and local awards.

Oriana House operates 23 facilities, located throughout Summit County, in Cleveland, and in Tiffin, Ohio, and will soon be opening another halfway house in Sandusky.
