- There were 17 reported incidences of sexual abuse during 2023 calendar year.
- Of the reported incidences, there were 13 male victims and four female victims during the calendar year 2023.
- allegations decreased in 2023, the proportion of substantiated cases increased 35.3% percent of the reported incidences were substantiated, meaning it was concluded after the investigations that the incident had occurred. Although total
- 43% of incidents occurred during the spring months
- 58% of reports were submitted by a third party (in some capacity)
- There was an average 10-year age difference between the alleged aggressor and victim

- CBCF had the highest number of substantiated allegations (2 cases), both involving staff-resident interactions
- Of the 6 substantiated cases:
- 5 involved staff vs. resident
- 1 involved resident vs. resident
- 5 male victims
- 1 female victim
- to ensure that all new employees are trained on PREA standards The agency continues to mandate training for all agency staff. Training is completed monthly on various PREA topics in each facility. The agency will continue
- any questions raised in trainings or any policy revisions. Updated memos are sent to all facility PREA Managers to assist with training staff and handling PREA allegations received. These memos are reviewed to clarify
- to sign an acknowledgment that they received the necessary PREA information. with a handbook informing them of their rights and options related to sexual assault, sexual abuse, sexual harassment, and/or retaliation. Clients are required by a multi-disciplinary committee. Recommendations are reviewed for feasibility and applied to minimize risk for clients. Upon admission, clients are provided Executive staff ensure that policies and procedures are regularly reviewed and updated. In addition, executive staff ensure that all PREA incidents are reviewed
- As a result of the reported numbers of sexual abuse that occurred this year, the following preventative measures were put in place:
- Re-evaluated camera angles and made adjustments to ensure better coverage of identified blind spots
- Review the quality assurance process for our PREA Screening Tool
- Update and re-assign our gender specific PREA trainings, more specifically the Women in Corrections Training
- Increase red flag, manipulation, and vulnerability identification training.
- the dorm assignments Adjust placements decisions for those scoring highly abusive and highly susceptible to ensure separation in bathroom assignments in coordination with
