## ASSESSMENT

Oriana House, Inc., is required to abide by the PREA Standards for Community Confinement Agencies that were enacted in June 2012. Oriana House has an existing zero-tolerance policy and procedures. We would like to acknowledge the Oriana House, Inc. Research Department for creating the report and conducting a trend analysis on the data.

- There were seven reported incidences of sexual abuse during 2018 calendar year.
- The agency continues to mandate training for all agency staff. Training is completed monthly on various PREA topics in each facility. The agency will continue to ensure that all new employees are trained on PREA standards.
- Updated memos were sent out to all facility PREA Managers to assist with training staff and handling PREA allegations received. These memos were reviewed to clarify any questions raised in trainings or any policy revisions.
- Executive staff will insure that policies and procedures are regularly reviewed and updated. In addition, executive staff will ensure that all incidents involving PREA standards will be reviewed by a multi-disciplinary committee. Recommendations will be reviewed for feasibility and applied to minimize risk for clients. Upon admission, clients are provided with a handbook informing them of their rights and options related to sexual assault, sexual abuse, sexual harassment, and/or retaliation. Clients are required to sign an acknowledgment that they have received the necessary PREA information.
- As a result of the reported numbers of sexual abuse that occurred this year, the following preventative measures were put in place:
  - Installation of camera equipment to cover additional areas of concern and an increase of staff supervision in the identified areas of concern
  - Increase awareness of internal and external victim advocates which entailed: 1) identifying the facility's victim advocate and the external victim advocate contacts; 2) every external advocated provided signage to be posted in the facility to increase client access to information; 3) PREA Staff Guide manuals where updated with the internal and external advocate contact information; 4) all staff are receiving additional training on who the internal advocate is for their facility through the monthly PREA Refresher Trainings.

<b>Unfounded allegation</b>	an allegation that was investigated and determined not to have occurred
<b>Unsubstantiated allegation</b>	an allegation that was investigated and the investigation produced insufficient evidence to make a final determination as to whether or not the event occurred
